#### **Online Service Charge Payment System**

1. Every student has to pay 200 Taka (Two hundred Taka) annually as online service charge.
2. Taka 800 for Honors or BSc programs, Taka 400 for Masters two years program and Taka 200 for Masters one year program must be paid during the admission procedure.

#### **Application Process**

Application must be submitted on or before 16 July, 2023 through online mode. In case of online application following steps should be followed:

- (1) If an applicant fulfills the eligible criteria and other conditions given in website may apply through [**Apply Now**] button.
- (2) The applicant should complete mobile/online payment (BDT. 1000/-) excluding service charge.
- (3) After successful completion of payment the applicant shall download **Admit Card**. In case of downloading Admit Card the applicant should use **300X300** pixel (size) recent photos. The applicant should bring **two copies** of color printed **admit card**.

#### **Admission Test and Merit List**

- (1) The merit list of each program shall be prepared on the basis of admission test and previous exams. Out of 100 marks, 60 marks shall be allotted for admission test and rest of 40 marks shall be given equally on the result of SSC and HSC or equivalent exams.
- (2) For Master programs, the allocation of 40 marks shall be as follows:  
SSC-10, HSC-10, Bachelor-20\*  
\*For the students having class/division system, the class/division shall be converted into GPPA/CGPA system as per the equation early mentioned.
- (3) The pattern of questions for admission test shall be quiz and short answer. In case of online test the time shall be 40 minutes and 60 minutes for class room exam. The marks for online exam shall be 30 and it shall be multiplied by 2. Both online and offline exams shall be accompanied by oral/viva voce exam, but it shall not carry any marks.
- (4) The exam system and distribution of marks of each program shall be as follows:
- (5) In case of online admission test following guidelines shall be followed:
  - (a) Online admission test will be held using Google Form/acceptable tools (created by the admission committee of the concerned program) through online.
  - (b) Test starting and ending time will be determined by the invigilator/s.
  - (c) During the test the applicant should open camera/video device used in the test.
  - (d) Google question form/tools should be created in such a way so that just after putting submit button it goes simultaneously to the emails of both coordinator and the Front Desk Management. ([rabindramaitree.office@gmail.com](mailto:rabindramaitree.office@gmail.com))
  - (e) The invigilator/s shall provide the link of Google form or other tools through e-mails or any other acceptable means before starting the test, but the students should start when invigilator allows. In this respect students should follow the instruction given by the invigilator/s.

#### **Calculation of Semester Fees and Payment System**

3. Admission fee or amount paid during admission will be deducted from the actual fees determined for a student.

4. Rest of the amount will be divided by total number of semesters and that should be paid during the respective semester.
5. Total fees of a semester will be paid in three installments, semester registration (determined by the authority, before midterm and final exam.
6. A student may pay monthly after deduction of admission and registration fees.

#### Hostel Facilities and Costs

Separate hostel accommodation for boys and girls are available on rental basis. Sharing room is available and seat rent may vary from 700-1000 BDT per month excluding AC and other charges depending on size, accommodation and situation.
